1. HG 1898-1, 1c blue on white, used with 2c orange Pres. Sam to Germany. Card is dated Gonaives Dec. 7, '98, with message in German. Card has "SHIP LETTER" in red, posted aboard ship, and apparently was received and sent on to Germany at Chester, PA, a port just below Philadelphia. Destination is Krempe, Holstein. Usual slight stains and toning for this, but VF for used card. Unusual. MB: \$35.00
2. HG 1898-1 used with 2c orange Pres Sam to Germany. Message in English dated 7 December 1899, Aux Cayes. Two clear Dutch packet oval strikes and receiving mark for Cothen in Germany. Usual minor stains and toning for this, but VF for used card and unusual. MB: \$35.00
3. HG 1898-2, 2c orange on pink, used to Dresden, Germany from Jeremie. Two reasonably clear strikes of Jeremie cds 25 July 04, Dresden receiving mark, message in English. No postage added, and no postage due charged. Nice, clear merchants cachet on front and notation By SS "Athos" via New York. Unusually clean and VF, MB: \$35.00
4. HG 1898-2, used with 1c Nord-Alexis, card dated Port-au-Prince 30 April 1904, datestamps on front are Cap Haitien 10 May no year slug. Addressed to Duren in Germany with Duren receiving mark, 3 June 04. Message in French. Card has some staining on back but front is very clean. MB: \$30.00
5. HG 1898-2, used with 1c Pres. Sam added. Card is stamped "via Jacmel per Royal Mail" and datestamped Port-au-Prince 31 Dec 99, and addressed to Dresden. Dresden receiving marks 19 Jan 00. No message, card unusually clean. MB: \$30.00
6. HG 1898-2, used with 1c Pres. Sam added, dated on back Jacmel 4 Dec. 1900, message in German. Postage cancelled by Jacmel cds strikes 5 DEC. Also on front, "per Royal Mail", addressed to Schwerin, Germany, with Schwerin receiving date stamp. Sound and clean for this. VF. MB: \$30.00
7. HG 1898-3 3c light green on cream, stamped on front PAQUEBOT NY 2nd DIV and "S. S. LAUENBERG" (mailed aboard ship), short message in French on back, dated Port-au-Prince 6 Dec. 1901, and New York receiving Dec 15, 1901. Fold marks and tear along fold mark about 2cm long at bottom center, old hinge mark along one end on back. Good to fine. MB: \$10.00
8. HG 1898-3 3c, Gonaives January 4, 1899, to Aguascalientes, Mexico, strikes of Jacmel cds 5 Jan. 1899 (2nd 9 inverted) and NY TRANSIT on front, Aguascalientes receiving stamp on back, Jan 21, '99. Short message on back. Card has one small corner fold at bottom left, otherwise quite clean.. VF. MB:\$40.00
9. HG 1898-3 3c, Port-de-Paix 6 Sept 1902 to Schleswig, Germany. Tondern, Germany receiving stamp, message on back in German, card is unusually clean and neat for used card, VF MB: \$30.00
10. HG 1898-3, Port au Prince 15 December 1899 to Berlin. Merchants cachet & German date stamp on front, message in German on back, small toning spots & fold mark in lower left corner, F-VF. MB: \$20.00
11. HG 1898-3, registered card, Cayes 11 July 1904 datestamps cancel and tie postage, including 8c and 2c Pres. Sam issue to make up the 10c registration fee. Card posted in Gonaives 11 July (cds), to Berlin, Germany. German date stamp on front and message in German onback. Vertical fold mark through center of card, scarce. MB: \$40.00.

12. HG 1898-4, 1c reply card, reply half attached (not used). Message half has 2c Pres. Sam added and addressed to Munich. Postage cancelled by rather faint Haiti cds strikes, town is probably Port au Prince, year date is 1899. Munich receiving date stamp 11 December '99. Slight soiling and beginnings of weakness at fold between the two halves. MB: \$15.00
13. HG 1898-4, 1c reply card, message half used Port au Prince 7 September 1901 to Sarajevo, Bosnia. No additional postage on card, and no postage due. Sarajevo receiving cds on front, message in French on back. Card has minor soiling. Almost VF. MB: \$40.00
14. HG 1898-4, 1c reply card, message half only with printed name and P au P address on front and printed subscription form on back, unused with 3c 1920 issue adhesive added, clean and VF. MB: \$5.00
15. HG 1898-4, 1c reply card Cap Haitien 9 May 1921 to Lyon, France, pair of 5c 1920 issue adhesives added on front and tied by indistinct cds, message in French with merchants cachet and handstamped name on reverse, card is clean and VF. MB: \$20.00
16. HG 1898-4 1c reply card message half, Jacmel to Guatemala City May 30, 1900, Kingston, Panama, and Guatemala datestamps on front, also "JAMAICA TRANSIT", Message on back in German. Card is in sad shape with heavy blackout of addressee on front and scuffs and waterstaining on back. MB: \$5.00
17. HG 1898-5 2c reply card message half with 2c of 1899 added. Message half is from Otto Kicher, Jacmel August 17, 1904, to Frans Kicher, Lagos, West Africa. This lot consist of a separated return half backstamped Lagos, W. Africa SP 26 04 to Otto Kicher, Jacmel. Owner believes this separated half is part of original. Back of message half has a message from Otto to Frans, and below it what appears to be a reply from Frans to Otto, both in German. The two halves are now separated but have all the appearance of having been used as message and reply. Both halves are sound and VF. MB: \$25
18. HG 1898-6 3c reply card, message half, Cap Haitien 12 March 1952 to Paris. Cap Haitien duplex cds on front, message in French on back. Card is sound and VF. MB: \$10.00
19. HG 1898-6 3c reply card, reply half, Port au Prince, March 8, 1944, to Puerto Rico, 50c adhesive 1942 "Our Lady" issue. Cap Haitien cds strikes and "Examined by US Censor" in circle on front. message in Spanish on back. Card is clean and VF. MB: \$20.00
20. HG 1898-6 3c reply card, reply half, Jacmel 27 August, 1925, to New York. Added are 1909 2 c de g lemon (interior), and two 5c Borno of 1924. Message in English on back, Jacmel cds strikes on front tie postage to card. Except for two light hinge marks on back, card is clean and VF. MB: \$15.00
21. HG 1898-6 3c reply card, both halves, both with 5c Borno added, P au P 25 Oct. 1925 to Germany. No message on reverse. Stamps tied by PauP cds strikes. Card is clean and VF. MB: \$10.00
22. HG 1898-3 3c reply card, both halves, Part au Prince (?) 1899 to Munich. Indistinct marks, but apparently received in Munich February 1899. Indistinct PauP merchant's cachet on back, no message. Card is clean and VF. MB: \$5.00
23. HG 1898-3 reply card image on thin paper, reply half only, Jacmel 4 June (no year) cds strikes, value ?, some toning and about fine, no minimum.
24. HG 1902-9 3c Gt Pre, Port au Princed 13 Dec. 1902, to Hamburg, Port au Prince and Hamburg cds strikes on front, message in German on back, card has small corner fold upper left, and slightly rounded corner lower right, neither detracting much, otherwise VF. MB: \$35.00
25. HG 1902-7 1c Gt. Pre, Jacmel to Hamburg via New York, two 1c and a 10c Nord-Alexis issue added and tied by Jacmel 12 April date stamps. New York registration label and strikes of oval New York Foreign date stamp on front. Hamburg receiving and short message in German dated 12 April and

Hamburg receiving on back. Card has hinge marks on back and a tear about 1cm affecting printed postage on (unused) reply half. MB: \$35.00

26. HG 1906-13 1c Nord-Alexis, "Per Prince William I via New York" on front and two strikes of Dutch Packet oval 20 Aug 09, addressed to Hamburg, Germany. No added postage and no due charged. One Dutch packet strike is faint; the second is about 80% legible. Lengthy message in German on back. Card is clean and sound. VF. MB: \$35.00

27. HG 1906-14 2c Nord Alexis, Port au Prince 5 August 1922 to New York, Bank of Haiti printed form on back with message. Hinge marks on back, otherwise clean and sound. MB: \$25.00

28. HG 1906 2c Nord-Alexis, mailed on Dutch ship, oval packet markings 3 April 1910, one nearly all clear and the other clear in the missing area of the first. Card is to Hamburg with message in German on back. Clean and VF. MB: \$40.00

29. HG 1906-16 2c Nord-Alexis reply card, Miragoane 24 February 06 (year inverted), to Germany. Signature on reverse, return half attached and not used. Hinge marks on back, otherwise clean and sound MB: \$20.00
