53. FL. PauP (21 July 1884) via Royal Mail to Marseille, France. Paid with vertical pair of #10a (yellowish green LIBERTY HEAD). 12 August 1884 PARIS postmark and backstamped in Marseille on 18(?) August 84. Fine condition

54. PauP to Jersey City, NJ. PauP postmark not clear but New York receiving postmark of 9-17-94 is clean and clear. Paid w/pair of #35. Fine. MB: \$2.00

55. PauP to Hannover, GE. Paid w/pair of #41. Originally via Royal Mail but cancelled off and sent via "Hollandaise". No PauP cancel but rather "Amsterd – W: Indie" Paqueboot cancels. One very clean dated 15 Dec 97. Backstamped in Hannover on 27-12-97. Fine condition. MB: \$10.00

56. Registered Mail, Cap Haitien to Havre, France. Paid w/#46 (10), #48 (8) and #50 (8) for total of 90 cents postage. Cap Haitien cancellations are very poor (somewhat unreadable). Backstamped in NY's Registry Division on 8-15-1898, and in Le Havre (date unreadable). Good condition. Tears on edge of cover **none affecting stamps**. Still a very nice cover. See photo. MB: \$75.00

57. PauP (5 April 1932) to Ashland, PA. Paid w/USA postage (#681). VF. MB: \$5.00

58. Airmail cover. Cap Haitien (17 March 1927) to PauP. Paid w/#318. Backstamped "USMC PauP March 21 1927". VF condition. MB: \$5.00

59. Paquebot cover to Pittsburgh, PA. Paid w/#329. Cancel "SS Cristobal May 12 1929. MB: \$5.00

60. Covers (3). PauP (23 Feb 26) to Germany and PauP (28 July 31) to New York, both paid w/#314. Third cover is an airmail cover fr Cayes (?) to New York postmarked 29 sep38, w/a PauP postmark of 1 Oct 38. Paid with #C11. Fine-VF. MB: \$2.00

61. LINDBERGH COMMEMORATING COVERS. Group of 4 covers postmarked at PauP (local mail) on 6 Feb 1928 (3covers) and 7 Feb 1928 (1 cover). Covers have the RED Lindbergh airplane mark over the stamps used. VF condition. The 6 Feb 28 covers are Mr. Carlson's mail (probably prepared by Mr. Carlson himself). MB: \$8.00

62. Unknown Haiti to Newark, NJ, paid w/#327. Cancel "K.N.S.H. (Royal Netherlands Steamship Co.) SS MEDEA 3 June 1935". Backstamped Newark 3 June 1935. Cover has cachet "First ship to carry cotton exported by Haiti to Japan via New York". Fine condition. MB: \$7.50

63. Cover w/PauP machine cancel 7 Jul 1936, to Houston.. Paid w/ #335, VF. MB: \$4.00.

64. Cape Hayti (no cancellation) to PauP. Paid w/strip of 3 of #70. Backstamped in PauP but date is not readable. F-VF. MB: \$3.00

65. COLLECTION OF 10 COVERS fr various towns such as CAYES, JEREMIE, GONAIVES, ST MARC, CAP HAITIEN, etc. addressed to PauP w/1991 dated cancellations. All covers franked with Scott \$844. Tow to four stamps in each cover. Excellent posted cancellations. VF clean lot. MB: \$10.00

66. **WWII Censored Mail**. Group of 4 airmail covers, postmarked in PauP (1940s), all addressed to USA destinations. Fine group. MB: \$2.50

67. POST CARDS. Gp of 4 different, color, unused post cards. 3 cards depict scenes of SAND CAY. These were printed by DUKANE PRESS, Hollywood, FL. The 4th card is a view of the cutting of sugar cane printed by MEXICHROME (France). VF. MB: \$4.00

68. Group of 18 covers, all w/PauP cancellations, period 1950-1960s. Great variety of different postage issues included. F-VF. MB: \$4.00

69. Group of 6 covers and a post card. All PauP mail to the USA. Included FDC of Scott #C181-82(Registered Mail); a cover postmarked 16 Nov 38 paid w/#329; and a cover with Society of Philatelic Americans cache postmarked 23 Aug 1945 (Registered Mail).

The post card is a Haitian Philatelic Agency notification to a customer in the USA (October 1959). F-VF. MB: \$3.00

70. NAVAL COVER. USS BERNADOU, DD-153, Fine cancellation April 10, 1931, GONAIVES HAITI. 2-cents Washington franking. VF. MB: \$10.00
71. USS CUTTLEFISH, SS-171. Fine cancel August 6, 1934, PORT AU PRINCE HAITI. 1 ½ cent Harding franking (Scott #684), VF. MB: \$10.00
72. USS ENTERPRISE, CV-6. Cachet cover (Shakedown cruise). Very fine cancel July 27, 1938 GONAIVES HAITI. Franking w/Scott #786. VF cover. MB: \$15.00
73. USS HANCOCK. This is a black and white post card showing burros used for carrying water and fuel in Mexico. Postmarked Nov 7, 1914. Ship is known to have visited Haiti. All mail fr this ship is scarce (25-100 or less copies known. 1-cent Washington franking. VF. MB: \$10.00
74. USS HAWKINS, DD-873. Not known to have visited Haiti. "LAST DAY OF COMMISSION" marking. VF cancel of October 31, 1973. VF. MB: \$5.00
75. USS VIREO, ATO-144 & AM-52. Known to have visited Haiti. An unusual special cachet showing picture of ship. Nice cancel of August 30, 1937. Franking w/vertical pair of #790. Location of cancel not clear – "San...? Cal..?". VF. MB: \$10.00
76. **FDCs**. Group of 3. # B9, CB16-18 & CB 24-27 (red surcharge), CB 24-27 (black surcharge). Unaddressed, no cachets. VF. MB: \$2.00
77. FDC, Scott #C1. PauP (5 May 1930) to Miranda, Oriente, Cuba. Backstamped in Oriente on 7 May 1930. VF. MB: \$2.00
78. FDC, #C55-56 (12 Oct 51). Unaddressed airmail envelope. VF. MB: \$1.00
79. POSTAL STATIONARY. Formula card #7, red on white, unused w/#9 (3c perf Liberty Head) affixed. Card VF, stamp just touched by perfs at left. F-VF. MB: \$12.00
80. POST CARD. Scott #162 on face of black and white PC showing "Les Cinq Ministeres, après l'explosion, PauP". Postmarked PauP 18 Dec 1913, addressed to Paris, France. 2 small tears on left side of PC, otherwise VF. MB: \$3.00
81. LITERATURE. Soft cover booklet (6" x 4"), "**The Postage Stamps of Hayti**" by Fred J. Melville. London. Vintage approx 1905. Cover loose, edges of front cover torn; otherwise, condition of booklet is fine. MB: \$2.00
