3. USS Dallas. Gonaives, Type 3, 1.26.31. Applied in blue ink to penalty cover. One killerbar somewhat faint, otherwise VG. MB: \$7.50 / \$7.50
4. [USS] Destroyer Squadron. Gonaives Bay [sic], Type 1, 1.23.25, applied penalty cover. Beautiful strike. Few light creases at upper left edge. MB: \$10.00 / \$10.00

49. Disinfected reg. cover Port de Paix to Chicago, Dec. 5, 1901, with “disinfected”
 hand stamp in purple. Paid by 20 centimes (issue of Simon Sam). Cover cut
 along bottom for treatment; some taping evident at left. Very rare!
 See HP, XV:2, p. 29 for similar cover. Good condition considering its
 handling and age. ([Web Photo](#)) MB: \$200.00/\$270.00
 50. Official post office seal on double censored airmail cover PaP-USA,
 September 15, 1943. Paid by 60 centimes. Seal placed at top and folded
 over. Thus when being opened, seal ripped in 2 parts. For similar covers,
 see HP XII:1, p.6. Rare!! ([Web Photo](#)) MB: \$150.00/\$210.00
 51. Postage due USA-Port-au-Prince. US stamp partially damaged and postage due
 of 6 centimes paid by J1 (x3) with ms. cancel. Also in ms. “6” to indicate
 postage due. Back stamped Port au Prince, November 8, 1899. Difficult item!

 52. Unusual usage. #CB 1 [Coubertin] on commercial airmail PaP-USA, paid by
 60 centimes. Crease at top; otherwise fine cond. MB: \$17.50 / \$21.00
 53. P.P (post payé) on Gonaives to PaP via German steamer. Use of hand stamp
 indicates no postage on hand at P.O. Handstamp (11 mm high) unusual in
 that it has period after first P only. Postmarked Gonaives 28/?/ 1902 ? and
 back stamped 30? Hinge remnants on back and tears above postmark at
 lower left. ([Web Photo](#)) MB: \$185.00/\$185.00
 54. AR [Avis de Reception] hand stamp applied in red ink [uncommon].
 Uniquely designed hand stamp [10mm tall] on reg. cover Cap H-Chicago,
 October 31, 1916, paid by #126 (x2) and 180 (2). Some toning and small

- creases, but overall good condition. MB: \$35.00 / \$61.00
55. Avis de Réception [Acknowledgement of Receipt] . Two domestically used forms: pink one (138x195mm) postmarked PaP March 27, 1931 & paid by #315, with Senator King commemorative cancel. Yellow one (133 x 175mm): postmarked PaP, November 25, 1953, paid by #371 & 384 and with 2 punched holes. Some wear at bottom of each. See p. 12 of HP XVII:1. MB: \$8.00 / \$8.00
56. Avis de Réception [Acknowledgement of Reception]. Haiti internationally used salmon-colored card, 118x220mm, postmarked Munich May 15, 1996. Paid by Haiti Scott #874 & 876. PaP receiving mark, May 21, 1996. Some creases. For similar item see HP, XXXIII: 1, p. 8. MB: \$5.00 / NB
